

Following are minutes for the 10/26/02 meeting (1:00 to 3:00 p.m.) of the Indiana Green Party. Please E-mail corrections if any.

Those in attendance were initially Pam Raider, Maureen Barlock and George Fish.

Pam Raider agreed to contact Chris Stafford on his status of co-coordinator of the IGP. Subsequently it was discussed that a change in By-laws should be made for inactive officers in the next Congress of IGP, that is, when an officer does not fulfill the duties of the position.

The treasurer reported a balance of \$559.44 in the checking account.

George Fish announced that Marion County Greens normally meet on the 3rd Thursday of the month and that there would be a candidate meeting for Marion Co. Greens on December 12, 2002.

Phil Hurst then arrived at the meeting and express interest in joining the Greens as a member.

George Fish said he would make contact with the campus Greens at Butler and Maureen said she would make contact with the IUPUI Campus Greens.

George Fish is contacting an individual for Massachusetts moving to Hamilton County, individual saying he wants to get involved in the Greens here.

Pam Raider spoke about the candidates for office in this years election, Julie Roberts, Jeff Melton, and Timothy Baer.

It was discussed that a lot of people did not come to this meeting because of the peace rallyies today.

It was discussed that Tom Brown and Dave Vollrath are working on Electronic meetings of the IGP on the college campuses in Indiana.

At 1:30 p.m., Jenette Tillotson arrived. Pam filled Jenette in what had been discussed before she arrived.

Maureen announced that there will be 29 city council postions open in Marion County in 2003 and that 4 or 5 Greens have expressed interest in running.

Jenette said that she and Tom and Graham were going to go slow on setting up IGP conference meetings and just setting up IU, Bloomington; IUPUI, Indianapolis; and IUSB, South Bend on their first trial.

Phil said as far as Ball State, that a schedule of teleconferencing would have to be set up a semester in advance.

George Fish said he would like teleconferencing in the whole state.

It was stated that Ingreens could use conferencing at campuses but not necessarily conferencing for only the Campus Greens.

Jenette said she will contact IUPUI Greens and schedule a date. She will contact Tom Brown, Harold Donle, and Jim Polly. Jenette set up a tentative teleconferencing meeting on November 16, 2002, 1:00 to 3:00 p.m., and if can't get that date, then will find available next date.

Jenette announced that the Ingreens website has been transferred over to a new server with same web address and same e-mail. She stated that she cannot update old discuss list as the person who has the password

has not been able to be contacted or found.

Pam Raider discussed what we would need to do to join the Greens U.S.- a lot of paper work. This is still in process.

George Fish announced that there will be a Progressive Expo next summer and Common Bonds asked us for suggestions on what we wanted. Tables for Marion and Ingreens for presentation of candidates, live band, food vendors. George will keep us informed. Pam contacting locals as Monroe and Brown Co. Greens to see if they want to join this expo.

It was agreed we need literature of the Party and need speakers from other organizations, buttons, bumper stickers, etc., all to be discussed at next meeting.
