

IGP CC minutes for Oct, 2003

Meeting date: October 18, 2003

South Bend connection to the PolyCom teleconference system was not working. Meeting was postponed to see if their connection would come through. Meeting was called to order at 1:34 pm.

Present: William Stant, Pam Raider (Brown Co. delegate), Steps to Freedom/Sean Bagley (Secretary), Isabel Piedmont (Monroe Co. delegate), Maureen Barlock (Marion Co. delegate), Jenett Tillotson, ????????????

Minutes from the IGP Congress for 2003 were approved.

Treasurers' report: \$978.30 in account. Two new members joined this month. Pre-election forms were turned in by Maureen as per state law. Announcement that any potential candidates for federal office should contact Federal Elections Commission (FEC) to request information packet. Candidates must file copies of FEC filing with the Indiana Elections Division.

Tech report: The Graham system which CC previously agreed to invest in is workable. Locals need to come up with sites where they can connect to the system. Secretary agreed to send out message to IGP locals to remind them to work on getting sites available for their local. Goal of CC is to have the December CC meeting using the Graham equipment. Jenett will schedule PolyCom for December in case all locals are not connected to the Graham system at that Time.

CC reviewed Congress mandates to CC as listed in the minutes from that meeting.

Discussion of Platform from Congress: The platform items agreed to at the IGP Congress are not transcribed at this Time. Platform to be sent out to lists once it is prepared. Platform Committee will work with unapproved platform proposals to come up with a platform report.

Victoria Webb (St Joe Valley Greens) was approved as Media Committee Chair. Secretary agreed to send out notices to state Green Party list-serves seeking volunteers to work on Media Committee and Fundraising Committee.

\*CC made contact with SJVG delegate. Three persons had attempted to be at the meeting from SJVG but tech problems in South Bend PolyCom site prevented that. \*

Jenett agreed to set up a new IGP list-serve on yahoogroups. List to be for persons actively working in the CC or in IGP committees.

Coordinators agreed to create a list of questions for potential 2004 state and federal level Green Party candidates. List to be available at November IGP CC meeting. Discussion ensued about 2004 election issues.

GPUS issues:

CC consensed to endorse FTAA Call to Action which had been forwarded from GPUS. Motion to object to language in GPUS proposal which would disallow delegates who had voted in Major Party primaries from serving as electors at 2004 GPUS Presidential Nominating Convention. Motion approved by consensus.

Discussion of button machine policy was tabled to the December IGP CC meeting.

Next meeting of IGP CC is tentatively scheduled for November 15, 2003 from 1-3 pm.

Meeting adjourned at 3:12 pm.
